

**Agreement on activity exchange between
The Geochemical Society
and
The Geochemical Society of Japan**

The Geochemical Society, a United States 501c3 nonprofit corporation and The Geochemical Society of Japan (hereafter referred to as the two societies), in the conviction that the activity exchange between the two societies will promote the scientific research of geochemistry, hereby conclude the following agreement.

Article 1. The two societies agree to have mutual discussion on cooperative and collaborative activity for promoting the scientific research.

Article 2. The two societies agree to seek continuously for expanding the activity stated in Article 1 including contributing to the V.M. Goldschmidt Conference™, a broad-scope conference covering all aspects of geochemistry and cosmochemistry.

Article 3. This Agreement is valid for two years effective from the date of the final signature affixed below by the two societies. The term of the Agreement is extended unless either party expresses the intention of terminating the Agreement. Either party may terminate the Agreement during the two years term by giving a written notice to the other party in six months advance.

Article 4. This Agreement is executed only in English.
